Dear Parents/Carers

We are pleased to inform you that our universal breakfast club pilot scheme will start from the beginning of term 5, Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> April. We will run this in conjunction with our existing offer so will continue to run a breakfast club from 7.45am each day. Please see the timetable below for further details on how this will run:

<b>Breakfast Club @ Worle Village from term 5 onwards</b>		
7.45 am – 8.10am	£2.00 per child	Booking required via School Gateway in the usual way.
8.10am – 8.40/8.50am key stage dependent	Free for every child	Booking required, for at least the summer term initially, to allow us to staff accordingly, via School Gateway.
Arrive by 8.30am		

## **Breakfast**

Breakfast will be provided for all children, for both options outlined above, and will adhere to the DfE's standards for high quality food. The club will continue to be run by school staff in the hall.

## **Bookings**

As indicated above bookings will be required, via School Gateway, for both the paid and non-paid options. This will allow us to take payment for the paid proportion of the club and to monitor numbers for both clubs so we can staff accordingly.

The paid club option will be open for bookings, via School Gateway, in exactly the same way as it works now, a term at a time and will be bookable and cancellable by parents/carers as usual, the only thing which will change is the cost. This will decrease in line with the free aspect of the pilot scheme. A small charge will be payable to cover the staffing element of the earlier start.

The results from our parental survey, for the non-paid option, suggest that up to 60 children will use the service initially. We will therefore, use this as a basis for staffing and will be able to offer the service for up to 60 children each morning initially, until we can establish a consistent pattern of demand. Bookings will be open for one week at a time for up to 60 children per day.

We need to ask you kindly for your support with the non-paid club booking process whilst we establish the demand and therefore, ask you to book your child/children on to the sessions you require, via School Gateway so we know how many children will be in attendance each morning. With this in mind, we also ask that you cancel any sessions, up until 8.00am on the morning, which you have booked but no longer need so they can be made available for other parents/carers who may need them.



### Key Information

The primary aim of the pilot scheme is for the Government to provide breakfast provision for every child before the school day starts. So, whilst we will welcome children to come into the hall if they do not require breakfast and you are predominately using the pilot scheme for childcare provision, we must ask that children using the club arrive no later than **8.30am**. The provision is not to be used as a drop off service as we simply won't have the staff available for this level of service. Parents/carers who arrive after 8.30am with their child/children will need to wait in the playground until the bells go for KS2 and KS1 and see their child/children into class as usual.

This is a pilot scheme for the Department of Education as much as it is for the school. We will continue to make adjustments to the provision according to the guidance we receive from them and the feedback we get from parents/carers as the pilot scheme progresses.

We hope you will join us in seeing this as an exciting opportunity for our school as the only primary school in North Somerset taking part in the scheme and one of only 750 primary schools across the country.
